Forklift Training Guidelines

The checklist below is vital for whatever workplace which has lift trucks on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety rules and regulations are being followed. A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural weakness that may cause accident, injury or damage to equipment.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is access to forklift areas by pedestrians restricted by a barrier?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are alterations to daily lift truck schedules communicated to all affected staff?
- 7) Are forklift tires suitable for utilization on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule followed?
- 11) Are annual checks of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the required tasks?
- 13) Does forklift has a load chart that is readable?
- 14) Do all operators know how to read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for different uses and attachments?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the lift truck working properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured correctly?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted right?
- 19) Do the operators of the forklift have certifications to operate the machinery?
- 20) Are speed limits and warning signs being observed?
- 21) Are forklift operators up to date on training for all types of forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators understand their duties to report any equipment damage and forklift incidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being utilized, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each and every day?
