Barrie Order Picker License - Order preparation operation or also called order picking as it is more commonly known is a method used in warehouse operations and consists of employees referred to as order pickers. The order picker's task is to take and collect articles in particular quantities so as to fulfill the customer's orders previous to shipment. Order picking is an easy warehousing process. The effectiveness in which this task is accomplished could be directly connected to a supply chain's productivity. Therefore, order picking is among the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls within the category of the warehouse management system.

There are specific types of order picking which comprise: wave picking method, pick to box method, picker to part method or piece picking, sorting systems method and zone picking method.

The pick to box method involves the order picker only filling the boxes with item that are from their particular station. The box then moves on to other stations to until the order is complete. In this process, there is no movement of the order picker personnel. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move all-around so as to gather the required things for numerous orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order picker or pickers move in order to gather the items needed but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking employees. Instead, the stuff are brought to him or her via an automated system like for instance a conveyor system or an automatic storage. In the zone picking method, each order picker is assigned to one particular zone. They are responsible for just realizing order picking within this particular zone.
